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GreenView at Karlkurla Selling Quickly

Sales in LandCorp's new GreenView at Karlkurla residential estate have been strong with 18 of 32 blocks in the first stage already sold.

"We were looking to buy a new home but found it was cheaper to buy land and build. We saw the GreenView site plans, and the proposed park and golf course which will make it a great place to live," said Ms Burnett.

"The blocks were priced far better than we expected, and we're very happy with our purchase," added Mr Siddons.

Mr Siddons and Ms Burnett said they expect to be living in their new home this time next year.

Blocks in Stage 1 vary in size from 425sqm to 903sqm, and are priced between \$155,000 and \$235,000.
